"She Shall Be Praised" By Curtis Carwile

One Tuesday night, I was driving Becca home from the women's Bible study here at the building and she was telling me a little bit about that particular night's study. As she was talking about it, she made a comment

about Johnna Purcell that I'd like to share with you. She said, "Johnna is the nicest person." From there, she related a story that illustrated her assertion. I didn't have to think about it very long and I agreed whole-heartedly. "She IS an extremely nice person." As I was voicing my agreement, I added "And, so is Erica... and Monica... and Lacey... and, well... we've got a lot of great women here."

The congregation here at Olsen Park is one of the most blessed places I have ever been because of all the godly women in our midst. I've probably only ever been a member of one other congregation that had as many truly great examples of what a Proverbs thirty-one woman is. So many of the women here (not just the ones I mentioned earlier) are loving, tenderhearted, kind, gentle, meek, humble, hospitable, industrious, wise, and godly.
